Equipment List:

- Klondike Sled Per Patrol
- Water for the Day – Yes a modern water container will be accepted
- 4 4ft staves
- 2 6ft staves
- 6 pieces of rope 6ft long
- Above-ground pit or trashcan lid for cooking lunch
- Wood for Cooking and a Small Fire Station – Can to dispose of ash (there is disposal on site)
- 2 Blankets

Skills for the event:

- Knot tying and lashing
- First Aid
- Cooking – Mid 1800's style – yes there will be a lunch competition and will be judged by mid-1800's standards
- Fire Building – Think what would be available for the time
- Teamwork

- 11:30 Lunch Competition Begins (Down on the Beach)
- 3:00pm Shut Down
- 3:15-3:30 Awards Ceremony
